Another to tour Bosteels, the brewers of Tripel Karmeliet, Kwak & Deus with a stop in historic Ghent.

**Taste the Food...** Belgium is known for its' mussels and frites, but everything else is amazing too. Think fine French cuisine without the heavy sauces. Lots of wild game too!

**Taste the Culture...** We'll meet the Flemish people of Flanders and the French speaking people of Brussels and Wallonia. Admire works by Peter Paul Rubens in the Groeningemuseum in Bruges, or check out the Royal Museums of Fine Arts of Belgium in Brussels. So much to see and do.

**Taste the History...** Bruges is one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, A quaint medieval city largely unchanged for centuries. It's like walking through a movie set... except it's real!

**Taste the Beer...** Belgium is a beer lovers paradise... abbey ales, lambics, sours, belgian triples and Trappists to name a few. We'll have the opportunity to visit De Halve Maan in Bruges, Bosteels near Antwerp, De Struise and St Bernardus in West Flanders, and more. This is a trip not to be missed!
